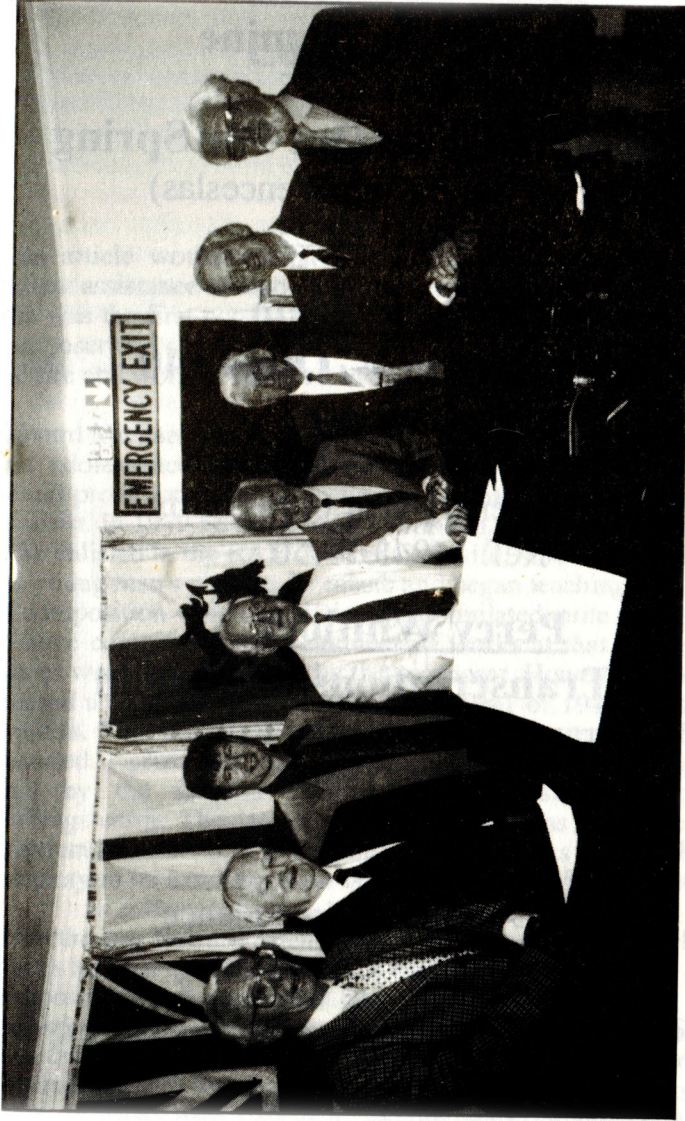


The Golden Jubilee Song Competition
